## HOT OFF THE PRESS LITERACY & IT

## ALL ABOUT THIS CARD

These activities will challenge pupils to be creative whilst undertaking literacy and IT tasks. You can use any match footage from the Vitality Netball World Cup 2019 or engage the learners in your own Netball World Cup!

## LEARNING OUTCOME

- Produce a match report on one of the tournament games.
- Hold a press conference to discuss a key moment in a game.
- Conduct a post match interview and utilise IT to present results.

## **ACTIVITIES YOU CAN ENGAGE WITH ACTIVITY 1: MATCH REPORT**

You have been sent by BBC Sport as their roving journalist to cover the Vitality Roses' matches at the Vitality Netball World Cup 2019. Using the worksheet to support you, watch one of the Vitality Roses' matches and write a match report that you would be proud of.

#### **EXTENSION ACTIVITIES:**

- · Watch one of the games as a class. Work in pairs to create and collaborate on the report, then share with another group to identify similarities and differences.
- Utilise the template to write match reports for all future school matches and share on the school website.

### **ACTIVITY 2: PREPARE FOR THE PRESS**

Split the pupils into players and members of the press. Download and print the Vitality Roses' deck of Top Trump Player Cards to decide who the players attending the press conference will be. Pick out cards at random. Stage a press conference before or after the game. The press team must come up with questions to ask the players.

#### **EXTENSION ACTIVITIES:**

- Host a press conference before a school match. Encourage the press to take photographs/record footage during the game and follow up with post-match player interviews.
- Utilise the findings in a match report, a website blog or piece to camera for the school website.

### ACTIVITY 3: GETTING TO KNOW YOU

You are the Vitality Roses' Press Manager; it is your role to get the public to know all about the players. Find out as much information as you can about one of the players and find a creative way of sharing this information with the general public.

#### **EXTENSION ACTIVITIES:**

• Use the dual career cards and Vitality Roses' Top Trump Player Cards to help you or complete further research using the internet. Find a creative way to report this back.
