# Late Players



-  A match can begin with a minimum of 5 players from a team on court
-  If a player/s arrives after a match has started when can the umpire hold time to allow them to enter the court?



1

After a goal has been scored

2



At a stoppage for injury/illness or blood

3

At an interval (quarter or half time)



# Game Management

-  Game Management is the term used to describe the actions an umpire may use to manage a match *in addition to the normal sanction*
-  Game Management actions are:

1

A Caution

2

A Warning

3

A Suspension (for 2 minutes playing time)

4

An Ordering Off (the player takes no further part in the match)
