

Neither parent or child have an ENA ID to book onto a Netball Youth Camp

Create an account for you and your child

- By creating an account for yourself as a parent on ENGage you will then have an ENA ID needed to book yourself or your child onto any sessions run by England Netball or our approved delivery partners.
- Firstly create an account for yourself, you will need to give some basic information as well as a few details. These details will also help you in the unlikely event of an emergency. These details are all stored securely and you will need to create a password.
- You can now create an account for your child. Once logged into ENGage, in the 'What Next?' section, you are given the opportunity to 'Add a family member', again you will need to provide some basic information and once completed your child will appear in the 'My Family' section.
- Repeat the last step if you have more than one child who would like to attend a Netball Youth Camp.

Find a NYC

- Remain in your ENGage account and scroll to the bottom to find the 'Find a Session' tile which will take you to the Session Finder.
- Put your postcode into the Netball Finder to search for camps near you.
- Use the 'I want to go to...' filter to find Netball Youth Camps.
- Select the Netball Youth Camp you would like your child to attend and click 'book'.
- In the 'My Family' section choose the child you would like to book onto your chosen camp (it will only let you book if your child is the correct age for that particular camp).
- In the 'Tickets' section click 'Add to Basket'

Reserve your Child's space

- You will now be able to pay for and finalise your child's booking onto your chosen Netball Youth Camp through the checkout process.
- You will be asked to answer a few very short questionnaires including medical information and emergency contacts.
- Once payment has gone through you will be given a payment reference and will receive email confirmation of your booking via the email address registered to your ENGage account.
- Further information regarding the camp will be circulated closer to the date of the camp.
