1	A goal circle is located at each end of the court.	
2	If two opposing players enter an offside area simultaneously and one player makes contact with the ball, a free pass is awarded.	
3	The sanction for a contact infringement is a free pass.	
4	A player may appeal against the decision of an umpire.	
5	A standard match consists of two halves, each of 30 minutes playing duration.	
6	To manage a match the umpires may, in addition to the normal sanction: Caution a player.	
7	A player who arrives after the game has started must be checked by an umpire before taking the court.	
8	A player who lands on both feet simultaneously may move both feet before releasing the ball.	
9	Umpires change ends at the start of each quarter.	
10	An opposing player who is the correct distance from a player with the ball may attempt to intercept the ball if the player with the ball reduces the distance between them.	
11	At a centre pass the Centre in possession of the ball stands with at least one foot wholly within the centre circle.	
12	A goal post consists of a vertical metal pole which is 3.05 m (10 ft) high.	
13	The ball is out of court when it touches any person or object in contact with the ground outside the court.	
14	If a player takes a free pass or penalty pass from the incorrect position the umpire will award a penalty pass to the opposing team.	
15	At a stoppage for injury or illness, the coach may come onto the court.	
16	The sanction for held ball is a Penalty Pass.	
17	A player is permitted to wear sports shoes with spiked soles.	
18	Where appropriate the umpire notifies the players when 15 seconds remain prior to the end of a stoppage.	
19	When the ball is ruled to be out of court play restarts with a throw in.
