Camp Information:

- Open to children with all disabilities aged between 6 and 12.
- Venue: Ballincollig RFC.
- Days: Tuesday 23rd, Wednesday 24th, Thursday 25th August.
- Times: 2.00pm 4.00pm each day .
- · Cost: €50.
- Kit: Adidas Munster Rugby T-shirt, Munster drawstring bag.
- Bring a water bottle to keep hydrated and a small snack.
- Brinng a waterproof rain jacket and additional footwear to cover outdoor (grass pitch).
