



JOB DESCRIPTION & RESPONSIBILITY STATEMENT

1. POST TITLE: Lead Academy & Pathway Physiotherapist, Munster

2. ROLE AND PURPOSE OF POSITION

- The role provides all aspects of physiotherapy care both proactive and reactive to the Munster Academy, National Talent Squad (NTS) and National Women's players based in Munster.

3. RESPONSIBILITIES

- Develop and co-ordinate the planning and delivery of injury management programmes across the academy & NTS pathways.
- It involves assisting with the local development and integration of the proposed injury monitoring system and ensure that the injury data is kept up to date.
- Work closely with other specialists and the Munster Rugby performance staff especially in the prehabilitation and injury rehabilitation of players.
- It involves screening for all academy players at the start of the season and implementing individual robustness programmes as required.
- Complete pre-signing and exit medicals as required.
- Matchday physiotherapy cover for Munster A games, at both home and away fixtures.
- Accompany Munster Academy players, where possible, on visits to consultants.
- Maintain up to date notes on the online player medical management system.
- Liaise with appropriate stakeholders both provincially & nationally on all relevant matters relating to players injuries and progress.
- Communicate regularly with the Munster & IRFU Medical & Athletic Performance departments regarding any physiotherapy issues related to player welfare or performance.
- Communicate with coaches regarding progress of injured players on a regular basis.
- Carry out any other duties that may be assigned from time to time
