ACCESSIBILITY

RAIL: The East Coast Mainline from London King's Cross to Aberdeen is a direct line through Newcastle, Morpeth, Alnmouth and Berwick. Connecting westbound services are run by CrossCountry and Hadrian's Wall Country Line.

ROAD: Berwick-upon-Tweed is accessible via the A1.
