Coming to Pershore for the OVO Energy Tour of Britain individual time trial stage on Thursday 12 September?

Please consider the following information when planning your journey ahead of race day.

ACCESSIBILITY

RAIL: Served by GreatWestern Railway Trains from London, Oxford, Reading and Worcester, Pershore station is approximately a 30-minute walk from the stage six start/finish area.

CAR PARKING: All-day parking is available at Pershore College (WR10 3JP) for just £2!

Spectators **MUST** be parked no later than 11:30 – access will be restricted after this until after the stage finish (approximately 15:30).

ROAD CLOSURES

Road closures in Pershore will be actioned in four stages.

05:00 to 19:00

Broad Street, Church Walk

09:30 to 19:00

High Street, Church Street, Church Row

09:30 to 17:00

B4084 Bridge Street (lower)

11:30 to 15:30

Rest of time trial circuit
