The Tour of Britain, the UK's most prestigious cycle race, will be racing along roads near you this September as the race returns to Wrexham and Cheshire.

Come and watch on Monday 4 September – it's FREE to attend!



With the stage starting and finishing in the city of Wrexham it's a great place to go to catch the build up to the start with teams and riders presented to the crowd, as well as to see the thrilling sprint finish on Chester Street mid-afternoon.

Starting from Wrexham stage two will take in a route through Gresford and Llay out into Cheshire via Holt and Farndon.

Passing the famous Beeston Castle and the Peckforton Hills the route heads back into Wales via Malpas, looping through Bangor-on-Dee and Ruabon before heading back into Wrexham for the thrilling sprint finish on Chester Street.
