The Tour of Britain, the UK's most prestigious cycle race, comes to Gloucestershire this September for stage seven of the 2023 race, between Tewkesbury and Gloucester. Come and watch on Saturday 9 September – it's FREE to attend!



Over 100 of the world's top professional cyclists will be racing in stage seven of the Tour of Britain on a 170-kilometre (105-mile) route through Gloucestershire and South Gloucestershire.

The picturesque route will take in the Cotswolds, showing off the beautiful scenery and also the testing the world's best riders on the hills the area is renowned for.

Stage seven will pass through Cleeve Hill, Winchcombe, Cirencester and Tetbury, before

Chipping Sodbury and Yate mark the most southerly points of the leg. Heading back towards the finish the riders will take in Wotton-under-Edge, Dursley and Stroud, with a series of testing climbs likely to influence who wins the stage alongside the historic Gloucester Docks.
