

Swedish Rowing Federation is hiring a rowing coach

We are looking for you who have a genuine interest in rowing, top-level sports and have experience in coaching rowers. You want to develop as a coach and coach our rowers so that they can reach their full potential. You have high ambitions, are solution-oriented, capable of planning and highly committed. Through motivation and communication, you contribute to the development of the Swedish Rowing High-Performance Center.

Today we have a full-time employed coach and are now looking for another coach to take the development of Swedish rowing to the next step. You will work with our current coach in Jönköping. The coaches are responsible for daily training of our students/high performance rowers (*RIG and EVL*) on site as well as training camps and races. The coaches are also responsible for writing long-term development plans for their rowers. Since rowers often combine their rowing career with studies, you will interact with each school and deliver support and encouragement to the athletes to succeeding both in their studies and sports. You are also part of the Swedish Rowing Educational Team that provides educational training courses within the Federation. You will also support the Head Coach and the national team in the selection processes and other activities regarding our national teams.

Svenska Roddförbundet's high performance activities are located in Jönköping where the *Riksidrotts gymnasium Rodd* at Sanda Sports Gymnasium, *Elitidrottsvänlig lärosäte* (dual career-friendly university) at Jönköping University and the new Rowing Federation's National Center *Riksidrottscentrum* are located. We have elaborated a development philosophy for rowers who aim to perform at a high level. Our methodology is based on competence, technology and we are looking for new knowledge to develop the level of all aspects that are required to perform at the world's top level. The Swedish Rowing Federation collaborates with the Swedish Olympic Committee and *RF elitidrott* to further develop the Swedish Rowing High-Performance Center.
