Brest is one of the oldest and most beautiful Belarusian cities that will celebrate its 1000 year anniversary in 2019. It is a truly European city with reach historical, cultural and sport traditions.

The main symbol of Brest is the memorial complex “Brest Fortress” devoted to the courage and heroism of city defenders during the Second World War.

Ecological pearl of our land is the National Park “Belovezhskaya Pushcha”, the oldest natural forest in Central Europe. “Belovezhskaya Pushcha” is famous for its ancient oaks, whose age is more than 500 years, as well as for big population of European Bison.

Brest sport facilities, such as the Football Stadium “Dinamo”, the Ice Hockey Palace, the Palace of Aquatic Sports, the Track and Field Athletic Arena, the Handball Stadium “Victoria”, allow to hold the biggest sport events.



ABOUT BREST



Brest lies at the crossroads of several major motorways and railroads connecting it with Vilnius, Moscow, Bryansk, Keiv, Warsaw, Bialostock..The city is part of transit corridor No.2 (London-Berlin-Warsaw-Brest-Minsk-Moscow).

One of the oldest towns in Belarus, Brest, dates back to the 11th century, and is full of historical sights.

The best known attraction of Brest is its fortress which was founded in 1836 and nominated as “hero fortress” during the Second World War. The fortress is not only a remarkable military construction, but also an interesting architectural complex.

Another famous sight in Brest is Trojetskiy Cathedral which was built in the 15th century, which is one of the oldest monuments of the beloved Belarusian wooden architecture.

Also worth seeing in Brest is the White Tower with its underground passages and narrow staircases.

ABOUT THE VENUE



Brest Rowing Course was opened on May 25, 2007 after a reconstruction of water basin and venue facilities. It is located in the centre of Brest.

Brest Rowing Course is a multi-sport and entertainment complex with a hotel, swimming pool, gyms, rowing pool, saunas and medical centre. It is a main place of training for Belarusian rowing team.

The rowing course has a length of 2274m, width – 162 m.

The 2009 European Rowing Championships and the 2010 World Rowing Under 23 Championships were hosted in Brest.



BOOKING CONDITIONS

PAYMENT POLICY

Reservation must be made by the **30 of June 2018**. A deposit of **30%** of the total amount is required to confirm the reservation. The balance payment is due prior to the **10 of August 2018**.

Prices include accommodation, meals, airport transfer and the shuttle service: hotel-venue.



CANCELLATION POLICY

All cancellation must be made in writing.

Notification prior to the 30 of April 2018 – **90% refund of all paid money**

Notification prior to the 30 of June 2018 – **50% refund of all paid money**

After the 30 of June 2018 – **NO REFUND**



TRANSPORTATION FROM/TO AIRPORT

The Organising Committee will organise transportation from Minsk airport or Warsaw airport to the hotel for Teams and officials who book accommodation through the Organising Committee.

Deadline for the airport transfer request: the 31 of July 2018.



VISAS

Azerbaijan, Georgia, Israel, Republic of Moldova, Russian Federation, Serbia, Turkey, Ukraine **do not need a visa to enter Belarus.**

Others should apply for a visa before enter Belarus. Please find more information about a visa application process at <http://mfa.gov.by/en/visa>.

Please note that participants of the **2018 European Rowing Under 23 Championships** having the letter of invitation from the Organising Committee will not pay visa application fee.
