IMPORTANT INFORMATION IN PREPARING YOUR TEAM:

Entry by Boat and Name – due by 15 September 2017 to FISA.

Follow the steps below to make an entry:

1.Clubs to fill out and send the entry form to the National Federations.

Entry forms are available on http://www.worldrowing.com/mm//Document/General/General/12/72/31/2017WorldRowingCostalChampionships-EntryForm_Step1vf_Neutral.pdf

2.National Federation to make entries by 15 September using FISA online entry system.
Club names and crew rankings to be included.

3.All Athletes to fill out **the new "Athlete Commitment Form"** and to send it to FISA by mail or, to hand it to the FISA representative at the registration in Thonon .

All crews must confirm their entries by 11:00 hrs on 12 October 2017.

Note:

In events where the entries are too large for the 2 day Regatta Schedule, a qualification system will be introduced. The entries, qualification and progression systems will be published on 23 September after entries close. Crews should be prepared to race qualification races on Thursday 12 October 2017.

Important notes:

- All racing crews must register – if crews fail to register they will be considered to have withdrawn from the Regatta.
- Start lists will be posted on official website and notice boards after registration.
- All competitors are required to have their passports/ID for control commission.
- All competitors are to carry their accreditation cards with them during the event.
- Launching time for boats will be 30 minutes before race start time.
- Official coxes weighing will take place 2 hours before race start times.
- A captains meeting may be called if weather conditions cause racing to be affected.
- The gender of the coxswain shall be open so that a men's crew may be coxed by a woman and a women's crew by a man. The minimum weight for a coxswain wearing the racing uniform is 55 kilogrammes ("kgs."). To make up this weight, a coxswain may carry a maximum of 15 kgs.
