Practice starts

U23 and Seniors crews will be able to do practice starts during training on Saturday, 20 August 10:30 hrs – 12:00 hrs. Junior crews will be able to do practice starts during training on Tuesday, 23 August 13 :30 hrs – 15 :00 hrs.

Control Commission

The Control Commission is located in the Control Commission hut [30](#). The Control Commission will be in operation during all times the course is officially open.

Crew changes

On arrival, Team Managers will receive a list of their crews as entered. Should there be any changes in the crew composition, seating order or errors in spelling, the Crew Change Form must be completed and submitted to the FISA representative in the Entrance and Accreditation Centre [17](#) before the Draw. For changes after the Draw contact the FISA office [24](#).

Crew photos

Team managers will be notified of the athletes that have not yet had their photographs taken for the FISA athlete database. These athletes should report to the FISA representatives in the Accreditation Centre [17](#) and have their photographs taken and passports scanned prior to issuing accreditation.

Bow numbers

Bow numbers will be distributed to crews on the outgoing pontoon and will be collected again at the incoming pontoon.

GPS Devices

All boats must be fitted with a 'base plate' to hold the GPS timing devices. These plates will be fixed to the boats by a team of OC volunteers and by Swiss Timing technicians from 17 August, 10:00 hrs in the Boat Weighing area [27](#). Please ensure they are in place before the first day of racing.

Advertising

Please check the FISA Rules of Racing and related Bye-Laws to ensure that your racing uniforms and boats comply with the advertising rules.

E. TEAM FACILITIES AND SERVICES

Classification of para-rowers

No classification will take place during the regatta.

Boat weighing

Boat weighing will take place in the main building, ground floor 27. Test scales will be available from Wednesday 17 August, noon and will be open at all times that the venue is open, except during racing.

Athlete weighing

Athlete weighing will be located in the main building, ground floor 26. Test scales will be available from Wednesday, 17 August, noon and will be open during the opening hours of the venue.

Spare races

U23 and Senior spare races will be held on Saturday, 20 August at 12:30 hrs.

Junior spare races will be held on Tuesday, 23 August at 16:00 hrs.

Entry forms are available at the FISA desk in the Accreditation office. Entry forms should be submitted by 16:00 hrs on Friday, 19 August 2016.

Boat storage

The boat racks are situated in the boathouse and the boathouse area 41. The Organising Committee will assign boat racks for all boats. Boats will be stored by boat type. Teams are responsible to make sure that their boats are safely tied to the racks at all times and are in no-risk to be damaged due to adverse weather conditions.

Team Tents

At the venue the space for team tents is limited. Team Managers will have to inform the Venue manager (by sending an e-mail to wim.jonkman@rotterdam2016.com) four weeks before arrival if they are bringing their own team tents. In this request, the number, size of the tents and additional space (if needed) must be indicated. There is no guaranty that the total requested space will be granted. The granted space will be marked on the ground. The OC will provide outlets for electricity (only 230 Volt). Do not forget to bring your own 2 pins socket plugs (travel adapter).

Boat repair

Boat builders and boat repair workshops are located in the boathouse area **28**.

Launch pontoons

There are two outgoing and two incoming pontoons.

Boat washing

No chemical detergents or other sources of environmental pollutants should be used for boat washing. The boat washing area is in front of the boathouse **42**.

Ergometers

Ergometers are provided in the Warming-Up Area **34**.

Changing rooms

The changing rooms are situated on the ground floor in the main building **44**.

Bag storage

There will be a secure area on the ground floor in the main building **32** for athlete's bag storage. The bag drop-off will be open during the official opening times of the course.

Sanitary facilities/ toilets

There are toilets and showers in the changing rooms on the ground floor in the main building **44**.

There are also toilets in the boathouse area and in the spectator's area **45**.

Viewing for Athletes

Athletes can view the races on a video screen between the Warming-Up tent **34** and the Cafeteria **20** or, if seats are available on the grandstand, from the Grandstand **2** near to the finish line.

There is a resting area in the Rest Lounge **33**.

Coaches viewing

During training, coaches can cycle on the roads at both sides of the course. During racing, coaches can only cycle on the bank opposite the main island **37**.

Bike rental

Bikes can be rented at the Venue on a 'first-come, first-served' basis. Vouchers for one or multiple days can be bought at the Public Information centre **14** for € 10,- per day per bike. ID is mandatory. All bikes are provided with a lock.

G. TRANSPORTATION AND PARKING SERVICES FOR TEAMS

Transportation is free of charge only for the teams, which booked accommodation through the Organising Committee.

The below mentioned services are provided to them:

1. Bus transfer from Airport/Train Station to their hotel (upon arrival)
2. Bus transfers from their hotel to the course and back during the 2016 World Rowing Senior, U23 and Junior Championships
3. Bus transfer from their hotel to the Airport/Train station (for their departure)

Arrival at Schiphol Amsterdam Airport

At Schiphol Amsterdam Airport, an OC Volunteer will welcome the teams to guide them to their hotel shuttles. You will find them at the "Meeting Point" in the Main Hall (red and white cubicles).

Arrival at Rotterdam Airport

At Rotterdam Airport, an OC Volunteer will welcome the teams at the airport to guide them to their hotel shuttles. You will find them at the exit of the baggage claim.

Arrival at Rotterdam Central Train station

At Rotterdam Central Train Station, an OC Volunteer will welcome the teams at the train station to guide them to their hotel shuttles. You will find them at the Main Hall.

Transfer between accommodation and venue

The buses will wait near to your hotel. To go from the venue to the hotel you can get onto the buses at the parking (bus station) opposite the Entrance bridge to the Venue.

From Wednesday, 17 August to Saturday, 20 August:

Transportation for teams will be on a fixed transport schedule. Teams requiring transport must submit a transport request to the Info Centre Athletes before 17:00 hrs for the following day. Transport request forms are available at the Info Centre Athletes.

From Sunday, 21 August to Sunday, 28 August:

Transportation will be organised from 06:00 hrs until 20:30 hrs. Teams requiring transport must submit a transport request form to the Info Centre Athletes before 17:00 hrs for the following day. Transport request forms are available at the Info Centre Athletes.

Departing from the hotel to the Venue Teams can only use those buses they are assigned to. This applies in particular for the first bus that leaves at 06:30 hrs this will be checked during boarding. From the Venue to the hotel you can get on any bus that stops at your hotel. Teams that have not booked a bus or use buses which are different from what was indicated in the transport booking form, will only be allowed to get in if there are any free seats.

Team vehicles and parking

Due to limited parking space at the venue, teams will only be allowed limited use of their own transportation from the hotels to the venue and must use the official transportation system. Exceptionally a team bringing a vehicle can receive an accreditation for a team vehicle to park. This vehicle pass may be collected from the Info Centre Athletes **21**.

The parking for vehicles having a pass is located opposite the entrance of the Venue.

Transportation of boats and parking

Team Managers are requested to announce the estimated arrival time of trailers at least 24 hours before arriving (transportation@rotterdam2016.com).

On arrival day, the trailers will park at the parking opposite the entrance of the Venue (right hand side). Do not park on the road side. The maximum parking time will be two hours.

Please report at the OC Production Office **40** near the Entrance of the Athletes Area.

One of the staff members will show you where to unload and in what time window. Please provide sufficient personnel to unload the boats (boats can only be unloaded by team members). After unloading, the trailers should be moved to the long term parking for trailers, which is approx. 1.6km from the Venue. Please note that parking is not guarded. You will have the possibility to leave boxes or small equipment in the bag drop-off.

For larger volumes of equipment, please contact the Transport Office in the Information Centre Athletes **21**. For further information regarding boat reloading and the departure of the boat trailers, please contact the Info Centre Athletes **21**.








