TRANSPORT

Shuttle Bus Service

Transportation between the Incheon International Airport and the accommodation facilities at the Grand Hotel in Chung Ju City will be provided by the Organising Committee and covered via OS/FISA for those taking part in the training camp with approval from their NOC. Non-participants in the training camp i.e. delegates or family members will have to pay for their transport in coordination with the Organising Committee. A shuttle bus service will be provided free between the accommodation facilities and the training venue during the training and event period. All accommodation facilities are within 10 to 15 minutes driving to the venue.

ACCOMMODATION

The Organising Committee has appointed the Grand Hotel, located 170 km from the Incheon international airport, as the official facilities for the training camp at the following estimated cost (90 USD /per person /per day, including meals) supported by OS/FISA for a maximum of 3 participants previously approved by their National Olympic Committee (one or two athletes, 1 male and/or 1 female, and one coach, male or female).
Training Camp participants will all be housed in the official Hotel, in Chung Ju (Grand Hotel).

Estimated cost for participants not covered by OS/FISA are in nearby options (accommodation including breakfast, lunch and dinner):
Hotel River 3***: 100 USD per person per day (in double room, price per night per person)

BOATS AND EQUIPMENT (Boat booking sheet to be forwarded)

For Participants confirmed by their NOCs for the Training camp, equipment will be free of charge. These equipment requests should be sent to the organizing committee by the 1st March 2016.

The Organising Committee will provide a limited number of boats for rental during the training camp and the event. Additional boats without oars rental charges are proposed as follows:

- Single scull (1x), 300 USD/boat for the full period.
- Double Sculls (2x), 400/USD boat for the full period.
- 100 USD/Pair of Sculls for the full period.

All boats and other equipment must comply with FISA Rules of Racing.

All teams taking part in the OS/ FISA Development Camp will be encouraged to bring their own sculls.

WEATHER

The past average weather conditions in Chung Ju in April are as follows:
