
To organise **assistance to NOCs**, particularly those with the greatest need of it, in order that NOCs may fulfil their responsibilities to the Olympic Movement.



# RESULTS

**ATHLETES 2013-2016** (AS OF 31.08.15)




- **Women at the Sochi Winter OG 2014**
  - ▶ **198** women Olympic scholarship holders (41% of the total), of which 110 competed in Sochi
  - ▶ **6** women Team Support Grants (38%)
- **Girls at the Nanjing YOG 2014**
  - ▶ **151** female YOG preparation scholarships (45%)
- **Women at the Rio Summer OG 2016\***
  - ▶ **568** women Olympic scholarship allocated (40% of total)
  - ▶ **51** women Team Support Grant applications (38% of total) + 6 mixed teams

*\*process is ongoing*

# RESULTS

## NOC MANAGEMENT 2013-2016 (AS OF 31.08.15)



### ● Management

- ▶ **1953** women attending National Training Courses for Sport Administrators (30%)
- ▶ **133** women attending Advanced Sport Management Courses (MOSO) (28%)
- ▶ **59** women attending International Executive Training courses in Sports Management (MEMOS) (39%)

# RESULTS

**WOMEN & SPORT 2013-2016 (AS OF 31.08.15)**

- 71 initiatives organised so far in 2013-2016:
  - ▶ 54 Women & Sport initiatives focused on *leadership*
  - ▶ 17 Sport for All initiatives focused on *women sport participation*





# RESULTS

## OTHER OPPORTUNITIES (AS OF 31.08.15)

- OS supported the participation of all Oceanian NOCs at a Women & Sport seminar in Tonga, 2013
- 5 women scholarship holders (24%) for the IOC Distance Learning Sports Medicine Diploma Course 2013-2015
- 4 women scholarship holders (27%) for the IOA Master in Olympic Studies, Education, Organisation and Management at the University of Peloponnese 2013-2014 & 2014-2015
- 6 women scholarship holders (55%) for the M.A. in Olympic Studies at the German Sport University Cologne 2013-2015
- 4 women for the Women's Sport & Leadership Academy training course





# RESULTS

FISA ACTIVITIES THROUGH OS 2013-2016 PROGRAMMES (AS OF 31.08.15)



- **63** Olympic scholarships for athletes
- **134** YOG athletes' supports
- **7** Olympic scholarships for coaches
- **20** technical courses for coaches
- **1** project for the development of national sports structure
