

REQUIRED TEXT for FISA Pre-Competition Health Screening Certification

National Federations are required, under Bye-Law to Rule 99, section 1 (page 110 of the FISA Rule Book), to ensure and certify that the Pre-competition Health Screening procedures have been performed on all athletes competing in the 2015 World Rowing Junior Championships. According to the updated Bye-Law to Rule 99 for 2015, if there are junior rowers who competed in 2014, they do not need to repeat the resting ECG this year.
