Do you agree with the Council's proposal for Article new 39 - Election of Council Members or the Swiss Federation proposed amendment (absolute majority)?

### 1. Council's proposal:

**Article 3940 – Election of Council Members of the Council**

The Council ~~of the Council~~, with the exception of the Executive Director, the Athletes' Commission Chair, the Co-opted Member(s) and the FISA Continental Representatives and the Co-opted Member(s), ~~shall be~~ are elected for four-year terms by the Congress.

The elections for President, Vice President and Treasurer take place in the year following the Summer Olympic and Paralympic Games.

The elections for the Chairs of the specialist Commissions take place in the second and third years after the Summer Olympic and Paralympic Games.

The Athletes' Commission Chair is appointed for a four-year term in accordance with the Athletes' Commission Regulations as set out in Appendix S5 and in the Bye-Law to Art. 39.

### 2. Swiss Fed's proposal:

**Article 39 40 – Election of Council Members of the Council**

The Council members, with the exception of the Executive Director, the Continental Representatives and the Co-opted Member(s) are elected for four-year terms by the Congress.

The elections for President, Vice President and Treasurer take place in the year following the Summer Olympic and Paralympic Games.

The elections for the Chairs of the specialist Commissions take place in the second and third years after the Summer Olympic and Paralympic Games.

The Athlete's Commission Chair is elected in accordance with the Athletes' Commission Regulations as set out in the Bye-Law to Art. 39 (appendix S5). The Athletes Commission Regulations are designed in that way that all members of the Athletes Commission are elected or appointed in due time prior to the Congress that will vote on the Athletes' Commission proposal for Athlete's Commission Chair.

*Recommended for the bye-law to Art. 39: start the Athletes' Commission Election Year with the WRCCh in the first year following the year of the Summer Olympic and Paralympic Games.*
