Venue Facilities and Services

- Non-accredited vehicles drop off is +/- 1.300m from the boathouse
- Accredited vehicles drop off is +/- 300m from the boathouse
- Olympic village transport drop off is 50m from the boathouse
- Approximate travel time village -> venue 30 minutes
- Athlete rest areas – team tents, air-conditioned rooms, athlete lounge
- Ice Baths
- Ergometers (30) & stationary bikes (16)



Venue Facilities and Services

- Athlete viewing – seats in the grandstand
- Coaches viewing – cycling along the course during training and during racing following in a van
- Bike rental
- Ice – 3kg cubed + 1kg crushed per athlete per day
- Catering at the venue – 2nd breakfast and lunch
- Foods and drinks brought in to the venue by NOC/NPCs to be confirmed by IOC



Rate Card

- General Rate Card items follow regular procedures
- Rowing specific items such as team tents and power need requesting as a non-standard request
- Contact your NOC/NPC for any equipment requests

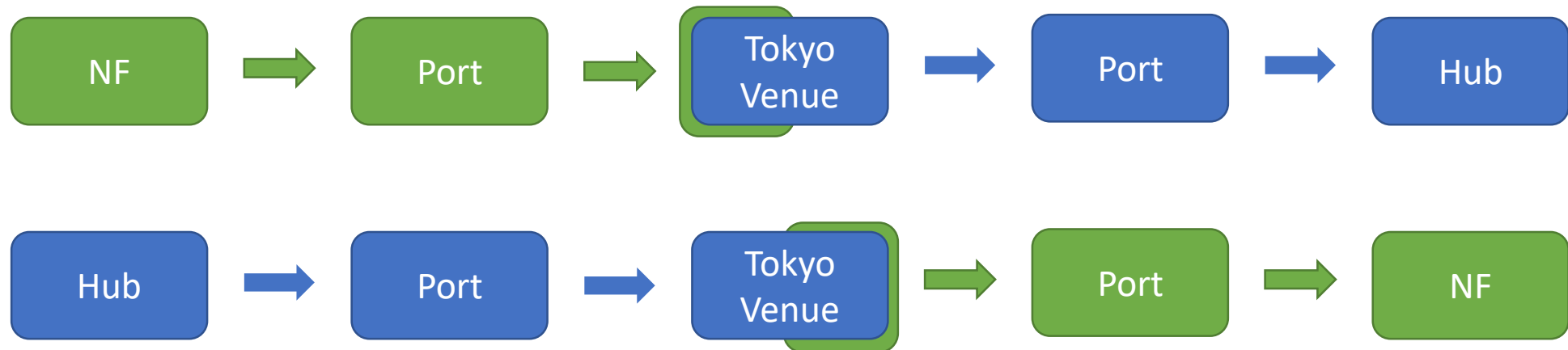

Freight Support Plan – equipment

- **Boat:** one boat per qualified crew plus no more than six boats per NF
- **Ergometers and stationary bikes:** Two machines in total (either ergometers or stationary bikes or a combination of the two) for teams with 12 athletes or more.
- **Other items:** riggers, oars, trestles and boat covers
- **All other items to be shipped by the NOCs/NPCs separately.**

Olympic Broadcasting Services - Olympics

- Full LIVE coverage
- 2 drones from the start to the bridge (750m)
- Flycam from the bridge to the finish
- TV catamaran
- Car
- **New:** live “behind the scenes” in the boathouse area (boat racks, boat builders area, ergometers, athlete dining).



Olympic Broadcasting Services - Paralympics

- Full LIVE coverage
- 1 drone from the start to the bridge (750m)
- 1 TV catamaran (1000m to finish)
- TV car
- No fly camera



Weather data

- Historical weather data will be made available to all NOCs/NPCs
- Window 1 July 2019 – 30 September 2019
- Data format – CVS
