In the Event of a Typhoon

Shenzhen belongs to subtropical zone. In the very unlikely event of a typhoon, note the following:

1. Avoid going outside as much as possible

If you have to travel, you must take protective measures, such as wearing good waterproof clothing. When going out, avoid areas near rivers and sea-shores and stay away from construction sites and dangerous houses to avoid damages/injuries.

2. Close doors and windows at home

If a typhoon comes, please close doors and windows in time. Clothes that are aired outside should be removed, flower pots and other sundries on the balcony should be collected so as not to be blown away by the wind or damages by falling objects.

3. No swimming at the seaside

If a typhoon comes, do not go swimming at the sea.

4. Don't touch any wires

Do not touch any electrical wires, damaged in the event of a typhoon. In case of injury or electrocution, use wood or cut off the power supply to help anyone injured.



5. Choose a safe parking lot

Before the typhoon arrives, it is better to park your car in the garage or parking lot, not under the trees or dangerous houses or in low-lying areas.

6. Call for rescue

If you are trapped in the storm, do not panic, contact relatives and friends in time or directly contact the 110 emergency contact, and choose self-rescue measures according to the actual situation.

The south of China in October can be sunny with mild temperatures or cool after a spatter of rain. The waters in Dameisha are not cold (approx. 20° C). Teams are recommended to prepare for all weather conditions.

Insurance

Teams are responsible for having their Insurance, in accordance with Rule 22 of the FISA Rules of Racing.

Crews are reminded to observe the FISA Rules, Appendix 23: point 10. The Draw and Determining the Lanes (Coastal Regulation 21, Rule 68) for the determining of the lanes during the competition.



TEAM FACILITIES AND SERVICES

Boats and Equipment

The organising committee will provide pool boats and oars for shared use. All boats, oars and other equipment shall comply with FISA Rules of Racing, including specified safety equipment. All boats and oars will be shared between teams, and the organising committee cannot guarantee teams will maintain same boat and oars each day.

To avoid problems at China Customs, teams are recommended not to bring oars to the event. For special requirement, please contact the organising committee in advance.

Boat Weighing

The boat weigh-in tent is located near the Boats & Oars storage. Boats will be weighed before the start of the Competition.

Athlete Weighing

Weighing will be for Coxswains only. The Athlete Weighing tent is located near the Storage room.

Lost and Found

For any lost items please report to the Team Information tent and the venue, or the Reception Desk at the hotels.

Drinking Water

Large bottles of barrelled water and reusable cups are provided on site. Teams are recommended to bring their own reusable water bottles.



FISA Office

Athlete rest, changing room and warm up area


At the venue there is an ergo warm-up area, athlete rest area and changing rooms, toilets and showers provided.
