TRAFFIC RULES

Training

The traffic rules for training apply at all times that the course is open for training (see Appendix).

Racing

The traffic rules for racing apply from 20 minutes before the start of first race until the end of the last race of each racing session (see Appendix).

Para-Rowing Training

PR1 and PR2 can train on the dedicated Para-Rowing Training Course during all official training sessions. PR3 can train on the main course during all official training sessions.

Shared Training

On training days, shared training takes place from 08:00 – 10:00 hrs and 13:30 – 15:00 hrs (PR1 and PR2 in the middle lanes only).

On racing days, shared training takes place from 07:00 – 08:00 hrs, during the lunch break training, and 20 mins after the start of the last race of the day for one hour (PR1 and PR2 in the middle lanes only).

Practice Starts

Teams will be able to practice starts with the Automatic Start System during training on Friday, 23 August and Saturday, 24 August from 10:00 – 11:00 hrs.

PR1 and PR2 practice starts take place on Friday, 23 August and Saturday, 24 August from 13:30 – 15:00 hrs. The course will be closed at 500m for the other training crews.

Traffic rules for practice starts can be collected from the Teams' mailboxes at the Team Information Centre [24](#).

Spares' Races

Spares' Races will be held on Saturday, 24 August at 11:00 hrs. Entry forms are available from the FISA desk in the Accreditation Office [9](#). Entry forms should be submitted by Friday, 23 August, at 16:00 hrs at the latest.

Control Commission

The Control Commission [27](#) is located between the incoming and outgoing pontoons and will be in operation during course opening hours.

Crew Changes

On arrival, Team Managers will receive a list of their crews as entered. Should there be any changes in the crew composition, seating order or errors in the spelling of the names of the athletes, a Crew Change Form must be completed and submitted to the FISA representative in the Accreditation Office [9](#) before 12:00 hrs before the Draw. For changes after the Draw contact the FISA Office [15](#).

Crew Photos

Team managers will be notified of the athletes that have not yet had their photographs taken for the FISA athlete database. These athletes should report to the Accreditation Office [9](#) and have their photographs taken and passports scanned prior to issuing accreditation.

Bow Numbers

Bow numbers will be distributed to crews on the outgoing pontoon and will be collected again at the incoming pontoon.

GPS Devices

All boats must be fitted with a 'base plate' to hold the GPS timing devices. These plates will be fixed to the boats by a team of OC volunteers and by Swiss Timing technicians on Friday, 23 August and Saturday, 24 August in the Boat Weighing Area **26**. Please ensure they are in place before the first day of racing.

Advertising

Please check the FISA Rules of Racing and related Bye-Laws to ensure that your racing uniforms and boats comply with the advertising rules.

Boat Weighing

Boat weighing **26** will take place in Boathouse 1. Test scales will be available from 24 hours before the first race and will be open at all times that the venue is open, except during racing.

Athletes Weighing

Athlete weighing **25** will be located in Boathouse 2. Test scales will be available from 24 hours before the first race and will be open during the opening hours of the venue.

Classification of Para-Rowers

Physical classification will occur on Friday, 23 August and Saturday, 24 August. Visual classification will occur on Saturday, 24 August. Physical classification will take place in the Para Rest Area **20b**. The visual classification will be held at Johannes Kepler Universitätsklinikum, 4020 Linz. Transportation to the visual classification will be arranged via the Transport Request Form.



Boat Storage

The Organising Committee will assign boat racks for all boats. Boats will be stored by boat type. Teams are responsible to make sure that their boats are safely tied to the racks at all times and are in no risk to be damaged due to adverse weather conditions.

Launch Pontoons

Teams must use the launch pontoons for going OUT in the water and coming IN as labelled.

Boat Washing

No chemical detergents or other sources of environmental pollutants should be used for boat washing. Boat Washing will take place in the Boat Park Area **16**.

Boat Repair

Boat builders and boat repair workshops are located in the Athletes' Area **18**.

Ergometers

Ergometers are provided in the Warm-up Area **22a**.

Bikes are provided in Boathouse 2 **22b**.

Para-Rowing ergs are provided in the Para Rest Area **20b**.

Changing Rooms

The changing rooms are situated on the ground floor of the old building.

Bag Storage

There will be a secure area for athlete's bag storage **21a**. The bag drop-off will be open during the official opening times of the venue. For Para-Rowers the bag drop-off **21b** is located near to the outgoing pontoons.

Sanitary Facilities

There are several sanitary facilities at the venue. Please take a look at the map in the Appendix for their location.

Rest Areas

A Rest Area **20a** is provided in the Team Tent Area.

The Para Rest Area **20b** is located at the back of the new boathouse building.

Viewing for Athletes

There will be grandstand dedicated to athletes only in the Athletes' Area **17**.

Coaches Viewing

During training, coaches can cycle on both sides of the course. During racing, coaches can only cycle on the north side of the regatta course (Finish Tower **12** side) due to TV car traffic.

Bike Rental

There will be a bike rental facility **31** provided at the venue. The rental cost is € 19.- per bike and day. Please reserve your bike in advance through the bike rental booking form: www.wrch2019.com/about-the-event/downloads. Cycling is not permitted in the Athletes' Area.

Cooling Baths

The area for cooling baths is located in the Team Tent Area **23**. Teams are responsible for bringing the baths. Spaces must be booked in advance for a rental fee of € 50.-. Please contact office@wrch2019.com to reserve a spot.

Liability

Participants are responsible for acquiring insurance for equipment and persons. The OC shall not be held responsible for any damages in the regatta area or hotels.

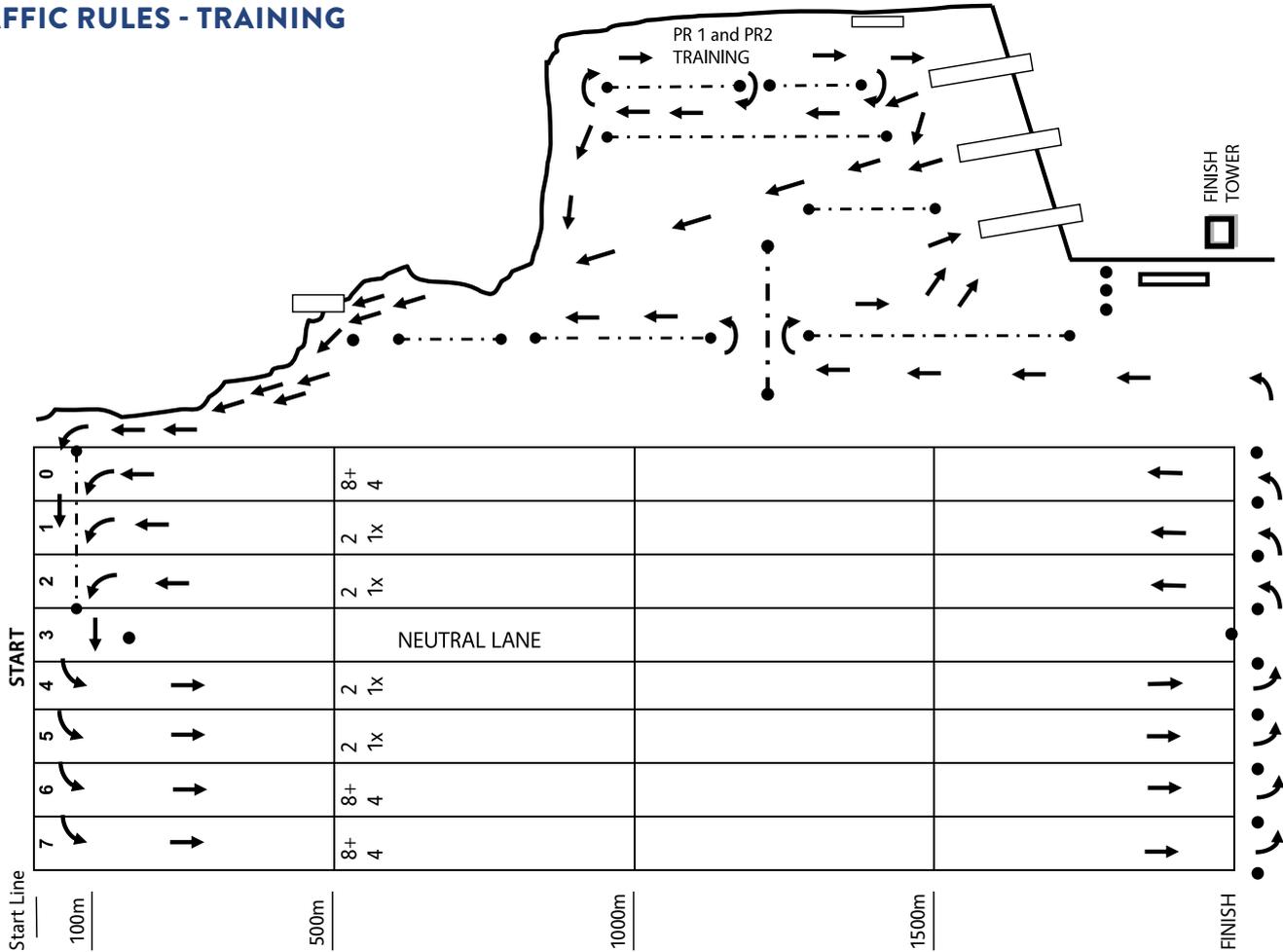

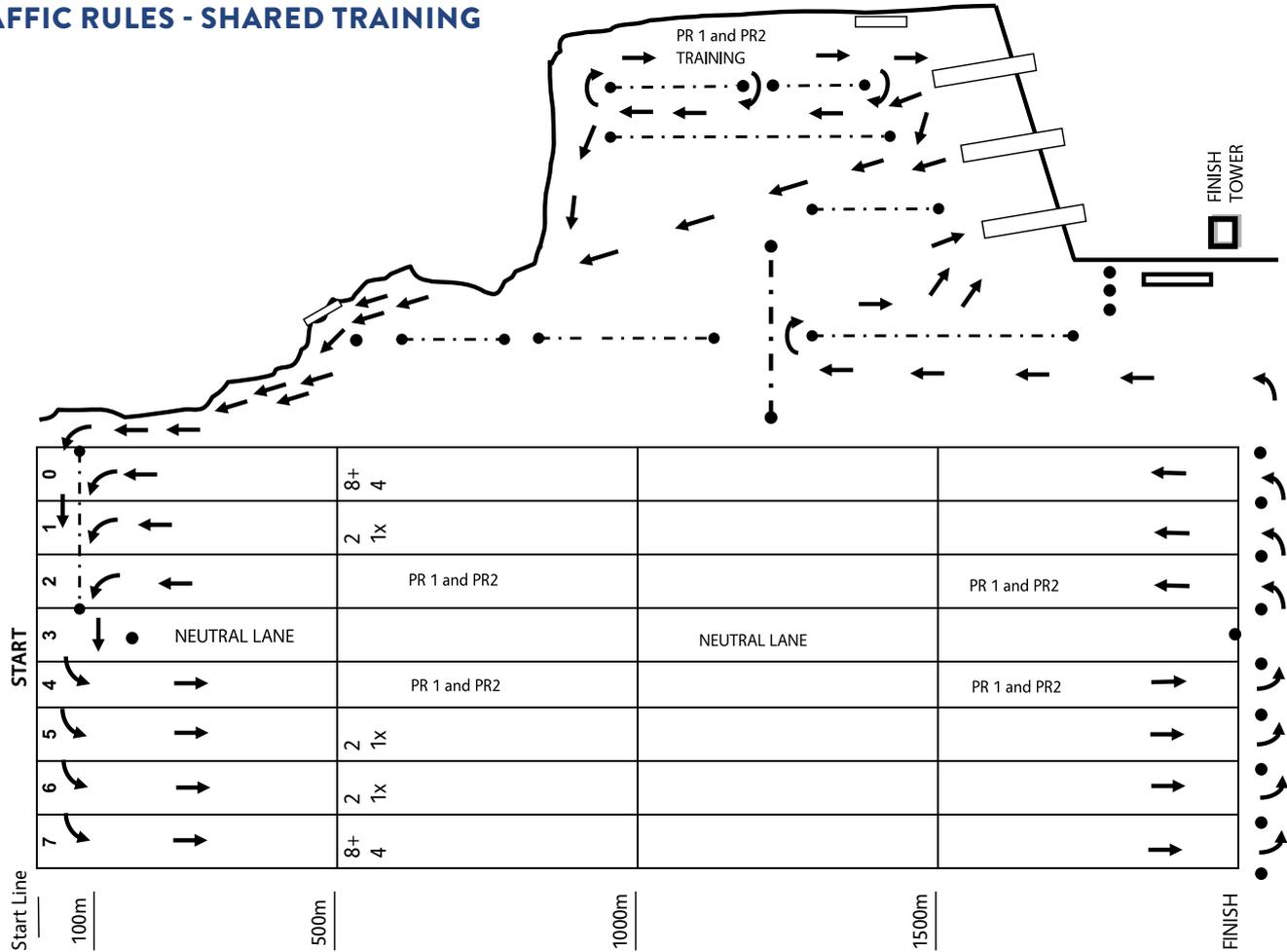

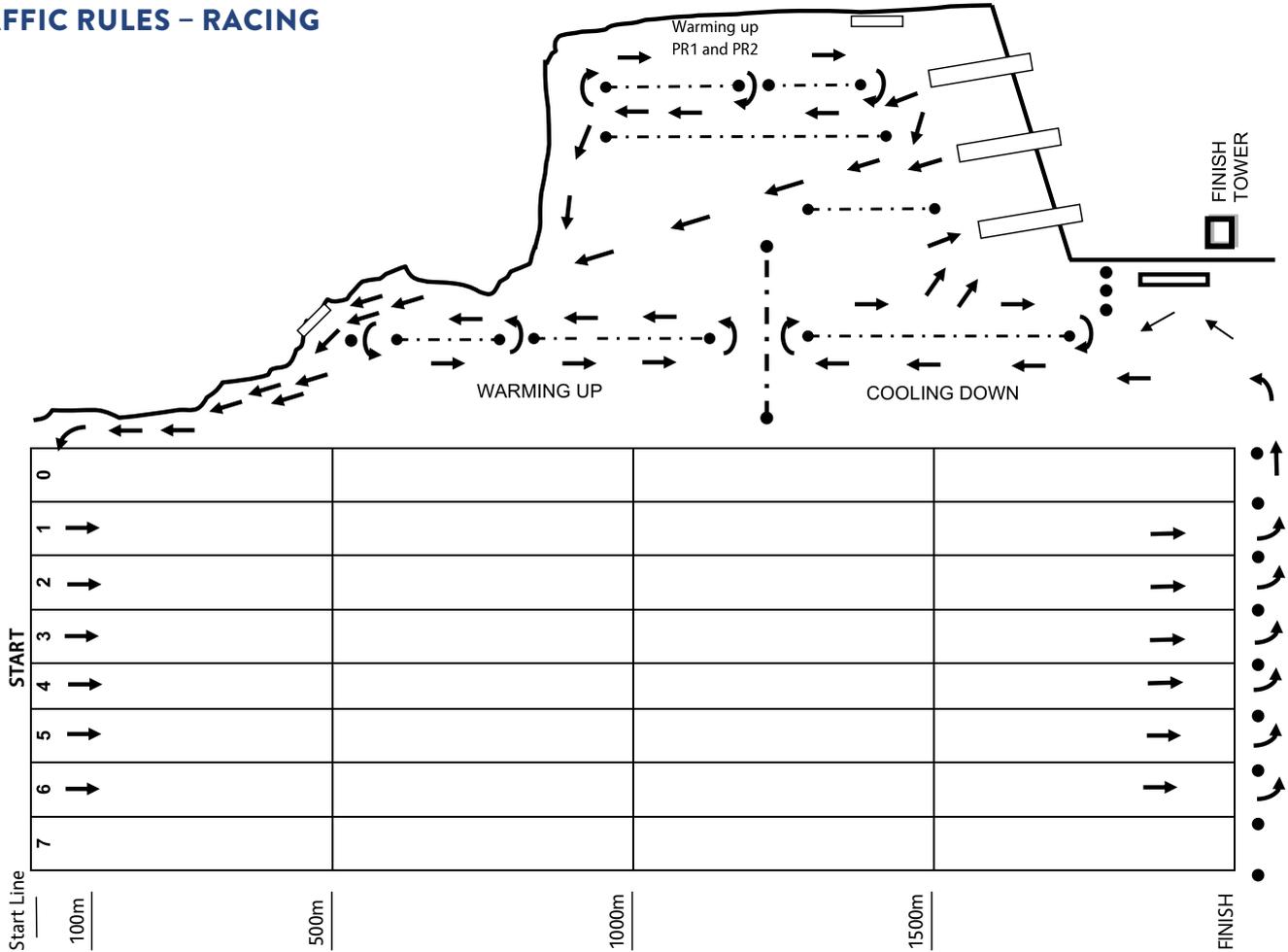
