



## **Danish Rowing is seeking a Head Coach**

### **Would you like to play a role in the continued success of rowing in Denmark?**

Danish top rowers regularly perform at a high level in international competition. Denmark won three medals at the recent 2012 London Olympic Games which placed it in the top-four best Rowing Nations in the world. It is the goal of Danish rowing to continue this success and to achieve even greater results at top international level. To lead the ambition, Danish rowing wishes to appoint a coach responsible for the lightweight sculling group (women's and men's).

#### **Job description:**

To achieve this task, the ideal candidate is highly experienced in coaching high performance rowers. The ideal candidate is an internationally recognized coach. The successful candidate must work closely with the other head coaches to help creating the best possible environment for Danish rowing. The coach will assist the lightweight sculling rowers to reach their goals for the highest international level. The coach must provide an insight into, and understanding of the various levels of development of the rowers. A vital personal component of the candidate is an ability to inspire and motivate the rowers through regular communication. A large proportion of the working hours will be devoted to practical training both on land and water, in close cooperation with the current team of coaches, our financial support organisation Team Denmark, physiotherapists and other external experts. In addition, the coach must work together with clubs and regional training centres, to assist them in the development of club coaches and rowers.

#### **The successful candidate will:**

- have the relevant education as a coach and be prepared for further professional development.
- have proven experience and results in the field of international rowing.
- have experience in the planning of training programmes and of formation of teams.
- be able to communicate in English.

#### **In terms of personality, we expect the successful candidate to:**

- be assertive and excellent communication skills.
- enjoy working with young people.
- be prepared to travel widely in both Denmark and abroad.
- be passionate about elite sports.
- be able to work both independently and as part of a team.
- have the power to motivate and inspire.

#### **Terms of employment:**

The daily work will take place at the Danish National Training Centre at Lake Bagsvaerd. The job is a full-time position and the coach must be prepared to work outside normal working hours on weekdays and on weekends. In the course of the year the national team travels to training camps abroad and takes part in several regattas both in Denmark and abroad. The Coach will, of course, be expected to attend these events. There are between 50 and 75 days of travel per year and the Olympic season travel days are expected to increase.
