### **Education History:**

Master's degree, Electrical, Electronics and Communications Engineering – ESCPE Lyon (Ecole Supérieure de Chimie Physique Electronique) 1991.

**Professional History:** Recruited in 1993 by the EDF Nuclear Division, one of the world leading electric utility companies, Jean-Christophe spent more than 10 years in the generation field as engineer in a nuclear power plant (Quality Maintenance, Tests and performance, Environment). When France opened the electricity market to competition, he joined the Customer Branch, as Deputy Director of the local authorities' market segment of a strategic regional unit. Less than three years later he was appointed Human Resources Director of this business unit. When EDF decided to sponsor the London Olympic and Paralympic Games, he managed, from London, the partnership with the Organising Committee.

### **Sport History:**

#### Athlete

Jean-Christophe started with rugby and swimming. At the age of 12 he followed his brother in the small rowing club of Condrieu, on the river Rhone near Lyon. In 1982 he joined the "Aviron Union Nautique de Lyon". He actively participated in the life of the club as a council member and in charge of the senior athletes. More than 30 years later Jean-Christophe is still member of the club. JCR has had a very successful sporting career with his club (18 National Champion titles) and with the French National Team, first as Junior in 1986 (Bronze at the World Junior Championships) and then as senior until 2000:

5 world championship podiums: 2 gold in 1993 (4-) and 1997 (2-), 2 silver in 1994 (4-) and 1999 (2-) and 1 bronze in 1995 (2-)

3 Olympic Games participations (Barcelona 92 – 4<sup>th</sup>, Atlanta 96- Bronze and Sydney 2000- Gold).

### FISA

Alongside his sporting career Jean-Christophe was appointed to the FISA Athletes commission in 1994. He was elected as Chair of the Commission in 2002 until 2011, when he handed over according to the rules. The Council appointed him as a co-opted member.

### Olympic Games Sponsor

After 3 Olympics as an athlete and 2 more as FISA official, Jean-Christophe had the great privilege to experience the Olympic and Paralympic Games in another dimension; sponsor. Dealing with the partnership of the Organising Committee of London 2012 was extremely enriching.

In addition Jean-Christophe has been involved in the other EDF sport partnerships and in particular was responsible for the "Team EDF", a group of athletes contracted by the company.


