Percentage of female participants vs total (every three to four years)

2005-2007	29%
2008-2010	31%
2011-2013	33%
2014-2017	37%

## World Rowing Championships

On average, from 1978 to 2017  
Percentage of female participants vs total (every ten years)

Dates	Average
1978-1987	28%
1988-1997	30%
1998-2007	32%
2008-2017	34%


### World Rowing Junior Championships

Trakai 2017 set a new participation record  
316 junior women  
43% of total rowers



### World Rowing U23 Championships

Plovdiv 2017 registered 128 more female rowers than Amsterdam 2005  
a new record in the percentage of female athletes - 38%



### World Rowing Championships

Sarasota-Bradenton 2017 registered the maximum percentage of female rowers ever - 37%
