CV of Mike Tanner

Hong Kong, China Rowing Association

Mike Tanner was born in Tasmania, Australia and has lived in Hong Kong since 1974.

Mike has been involved in rowing and rowing administration since taking up the sport at school in 1962.

In 1978 he was a founding member of the Hong Kong, China Rowing Association. He has served the Association in various capacities since that date and is currently the Chairman. He has been closely involved in all aspects of the development of rowing in Hong Kong for over 30 years.

Mike qualified as an international rowing umpire in 1984 and was appointed Chairman of the Umpires Committee of the Asian Rowing Federation in 1991. In this capacity he presided over Juries at successive Asian Games and Asian Rowing Championships. He served on the Jury for the 1992 Olympic Rowing Regatta in Barcelona and in 1993 was appointed as a member of the FISA Umpiring Commission with responsibility for the training and examination of international umpires in the Asian region. As a Commission member, between 1993 and 2004 he officiated at the World Rowing Championships each year and at the Olympic Regattas in Atlanta, Sydney and Athens.

Mike was appointed as Chairman of the FISA Events Commission after the 2004 Athens Olympic Games. The Commission is responsible to maintain and improve the standards of international regattas and of all FISA events with regard to venues, technical installations and organization of the events. In this role he has been Technical Delegate at each World Rowing Championships and at the Beijing and London Olympic Regattas.

As Chair of Commission, Mike has also been a FISA Council member since 2004 and in 2011 was appointed to the FISA Executive Committee.

Upon reaching the age of 65, Mike retired as FISA umpire at the end of 2013. He remains Chair of the Events Commission and a member of FISA Council and Executive Committee.

Mike is married with three children, all born and raised in Hong Kong.
