

## **Revised Timeline for the Paris 2024 Olympic Qualification System at 061021**

This timeline has been modified by the IOC and the new deadline is February 2022. This allows more time for comments, analysis and proposals.

The Competitive Rowing Commission is now charged with collecting all “sport” comments and ideas in order to develop “sport-based” proposals which take high-performance, development, the Olympic racing programme and the resulting qualification system incorporating the World Championships, the continental qualification regattas and the final qualification regatta.

The Executive Committee will be assessing the management and political elements related to the relationship with the IOC and the Paris OCOG. These will be placed on a list and prioritised. Then each proposed solution will be evaluated against these elements.

These proposals will be presented to the Council and the Member Federations for comments leading to a decision in late January by the World Rowing Council.

(15 December – Executive Committee Meeting)

17 December – Publishing of Draft 2 proposals with analysis by Exec Comm

17 December – 17 January – receipt of comments and suggestions on Draft 2

22 – 23 January 2022 – World Rowing Council Meeting for final decision

1 February 2022 – Submission to the IOC
