European Rowing Championships

European Rowing is steeped in history. The European Rowing Championships was the first international regatta organised by World Rowing and it's one of the oldest pan-continental sporting events. First staged in Orta, Italy in 1893, it was organised almost annually for the next 80 years. In 2007 the European regatta was reintroduced at the later end of the rowing season. The demand for this event was clear from the beginning. Five years later it was moved to the start of the season, following World Rowing Cup I, where it fitted in well with the international season. It has experienced ongoing popularity and increased participation ever since with on average over 500 athletes competing from more than 30 European countries.

As with all sporting events, 2020 and 2021 was disrupted by the Covid-19 Global Pandemic. Despite this the championships was the only senior-level regatta to take place in 2020 and in 2021 it took place in Varese, Italy with 629 athletes competing from 35 countries. For 2022 the European Rowing Championships joined with the multi-sport European Championships in Munich with racing taking place at the 1972 Olympic regatta venue in Oberschleissheim. Last year it was in the beautiful town of Bled, Slovenia, that the European Championships were hosted – and Great Britain and Romania shared the honours of the top of the medal table with five gold medals each, closely followed by the Netherlands, winning an impressive total of 11 medals. Perhaps the best performance of these championships came from the Dutch sculler Lennart Van Lierop, coming in from lane 6 and beating the reigning Olympic and World Champions, Stefanos Ntouskos and Oliver Zeidler, for his first-ever European championship title.

The championship is open to the 46 European national rowing federations, including Israel. The programme consists of the 14 Olympic boat classes, three international boat classes (lightweight single sculls, lightweight pair and lightweight quadruple sculls) and a selection of para rowing boat classes. There are the same number of boat classes for women and men. Introduction The European Rowing Championships is monitored and managed by the European Rowing Board (ERB). Their responsibilities have grown to include the European Rowing Under 19 Championships, European Rowing Under 23 Championships, European Rowing Coastal and Beach Sprint Championships.

This year the small town of Szeged, Hungary is the regatta venue. The Szeged National Canoeing and Rowing Olympic Centre has a 2000m-long, eight-lane rowing course, with a separate channel for warm-up and cool-down. It hosted the FISA World Junior Championships in 1989, the FISU University Rowing Championships in 2010, the Coupe de Jeunesse in 2015, and the Simády Béla International regatta every year until the 2010s. The national rowing championships and other rowing events are organised here annually. The venue is also used for training camps.

The early 1930s can be described as the heydays of Hungarian rowing. At the time the Glandaz Cup was awarded to the best rowing nation. Hungary won it for four consecutive years. European Championship medals abounded and the number of rowing clubs grew to 38 nationwide. By the middle of the century women had started to row and single sculler Kornelia Papp won her first European Championship medal in 1955. It was bronze. She won bronze in the subsequent two years. Papp continued to compete and from 1958 until 1961 she dominated the single and won gold for four consecutive years.

Rowing remains very popular in Hungary and they continue to win medals in lightweight categories, at U19 and U23 level.







About Rowing



Olympic rowing regatta

Rowing became an Olympic sport in 1896, at the first Olympic Games of the modern era held in Athens, Greece. Rough seas, however, forced the event to be cancelled. Women's events were added to the Olympic programme in 1976 and lightweight events in 1996.

Para rowing first appeared at the Paralympic Games in 2008.



Origin

The boat was human's most significant mode of transport for centuries and the oar is considered to be the most important invention before the wheel.

The first representation of a rowing boat was discovered in Finland and dates back to 5,800 BC.

The earliest regatta was held in 1274 in Venice, Italy, where regattas developed as challenges between gondoliers and boatmen.

The origin of the sport of rowing as we know it today comes from England, where the Oxford versus Cambridge University Boat Race was first held in 1829 on the River Thames.



The boats

Boats, or shells, were traditionally made from wood. Top level boats are now fabricated from composite materials such as carbon fibre and kevlar. There's a small fin fitted beneath the boat for directional stability and a rudder for steering (except some sculling boats).

A white ball (bow ball) is attached to the bow for safety and judging precision of the start and finish of races. Seats are fitted with wheels which roll on runners or tracks.



World Rowing Championships

The first World Rowing Championships was 1962 in Lucerne, Switzerland. It is now the biggest annual World Rowing event. This year it will be held in St Catharines, Canada in August.

Female boat classes were included on the World Championship programme in 1974. Lightweight categories featured from 1985. In 2018 the championship programme became gender equal. Para rowing was added in 2002, originally over 1000m it is now fully integrated at 2000m.



More rowing

World Rowing has grown to include indoor rowing or ergometer rowing with the World Rowing Indoor Rowing Championships first being raced in 2018.

The World Rowing Coastal Championships were first held 2007 and is held annually. This is the rough-water version and is raced on the sea or large lakes. The boats are designed to handle rough water and waves. The World Rowing Beach Sprint Finals is the newest event, added in 2019.



The oars

Oars are hollow to reduce weight, attached to the boat by adjustable outriggers. The size and shape of oars is unrestricted, the average length of a sweep oar is 3.70m and of a scull 2.85m.





About World Rowing (page 1/2)

The World Rowing Federation is the governing body of the sport of rowing. It is empowered by its 159-member National Rowing Federations, the National Olympic Committees and the International Olympic Committee, to govern the sport of rowing.

World Rowing was previously called FISA (from the French, Fédération Internationale des Sociétés d'Aviron) with a full name change to World Rowing coming into effect in 2020.

World Rowing sets the rules and regulations for the practice of the sport in all its forms (elite, para rowing, coastal, masters and aspects of indoor). It organises sanctioned World Rowing events including those for under-19 and under-23s. It provides advice and expertise for the organisation of rowing regattas, events, coaching education, rowing development and other matters relating to the sport and its development.

In 2017 World Rowing, as FISA, celebrated its 125th anniversary. It was founded by representatives from Belgium, France, Italy, Switzerland and Adriatica (now a part of Italy) in Turin, Italy on 25 June 1892. It is the oldest international sports federation in the Olympic movement. World Rowing established its first headquarters in Lausanne, Switzerland in 1922 and, after moving away, it returned to Lausanne in February 1996. Lausanne is the home of the International Olympic Committee.



World Rowing's vision

To encourage the development of the sport of rowing and strengthen the bonds that unite all who enjoy the sport.



World Rowing's mission

To make rowing a universally practised and globally relevant sport in all its forms. To effectively and efficiently govern, develop, showcase and promote the sport of rowing and respect and protect the environment when practising the sport.

- **Integral Part of World Sport:** World Rowing seeks to ensure a leading position for rowing in the world of sport. World Rowing is an integral member of the Olympic and Paralympic movements and other leading world sports organisations.

2023 World Rowing Season Summary

For 2023, being a pre-Olympic year, the focus of the season was on Olympic and Paralympic qualification for the Paris 2024 Games. Qualification opportunities were at the World Rowing Championships held in Belgrade, Serbia, the highlight of the season.

Going back to the start of 2023, the on-water season opened with the World Cup series of three regattas. First up was Zagreb, Croatia with local heroes Martin and Valent Sinkovic bringing out the crowds and winning the double sculls. This also signalled the 50th international medal for the Sinkovics. The first gold for Chilean women's rowing went to their four which included rowing twins Melita and Antonia Abraham. Overall Switzerland topped the medals table.

Sneaking in between World Cup I and II, the European Rowing Championships took place in Bled, Slovenia with a large field of over 600 athletes. The Netherlands dominated rowing away with 11 medals including a surprise win for Lennart van Lierop in the men's single. He finished ahead of Ollie Zeidler (GER) and Olympic Champion Stefanos Ntouskos of Greece.

On to Varese, Italy for World Rowing Cup II, five World Best Times were broken by para boats including the men's and women's PR1 single sculls. Birget Skarstein of Norway reset the standard for the women's and Ukraine's Roman Polianskyi did it for the men. A dominating streak by Emily Craig and Imogen Grant of Great Britain saw them retain the lightweight doubles title after also winning at the Europeans. Craig and Grant then went on to win at World Cup III.

The final World Cup in Lucerne, Switzerland was highlighted by the lightweight men's double. France's Hugo Beurey and Ferdinand Ludwig outsprinted Olympic champion Fintan McCarthy and Paul O'Donovan of Ireland. Switzerland finished third with Angel Carballo and Alexis Bladmir in fourth being the first time Mexico had made the final since 2010.

At the World Rowing Championships all eyes were on the Olympic and Paralympic boat classes with qualification hopes taking the focus. For the Olympics this meant 114 boats across 14 boat classes and for Paralympics 31 across five boat classes. The British lightweight duo of Craig and Grant remained dominant and won the lightweight double by three seconds over Michelle Sechser and Mary Jones (USA) who are back together to have another Olympic shot.

The men's pair concluded a season of mixed results with Roman Roosli and Andrin Gulich of Switzerland finishing in the top spot ahead of Oliver Wynne-Griffith and Thom George of Great Britain. The men's pair relished the Sinkovic brothers move to the double with the men's double now stacked to the max. In the final Melvin Twellaar and Stef Broenink of the Netherlands proved to be the strongest winning over the Sinkovics with Daire Lynch and Philip Doyle of Ireland coming in third.

Ancuta Bodnar and Simona Radis of Romania have been on a winning streak in the women's double since 2020. It continued at the World Rowing Championships and put them in a very good position to defend their Tokyo Olympic title. In second the seasoned Lithuanian Donata Karaliene was back in fine form with new partner Dovile Rimkute. The United States finished third.

The women's eight saw the Romanians back on top with the United States in second and Australia in third. Oliver Zeidler (GER) won the men's single over Simon van Dorp with Thomas Mackintosh in third. The women had Karolien Florijn (NED) winning ahead of Olympic Champion Emma Twigg of New Zealand.

For 2024 these European Rowing Championships follows on the back of World Rowing Cup I which took place in Varese, Italy. The season will then go through the World Rowing Cup series and on to the Paris 2024 Olympic and Paralympic Games.

Interspersed throughout this season will be the final qualification events for the Paris Games with these European Rowing Championships also acting as the 2024 World Rowing European Olympic & Paralympic Qualification Regatta.

For Olympic qualification the quota spots include three for the men's single sculls, two for the lightweight men's double sculls and the same number for the women's single and lightweight double boats. For the Paralympic Games qualification will go to the highest ranked boat in each of the following medal events: PR1 men's single sculls, PR1 women's single sculls and PR3 mixed double sculls.

The Paris Olympic Games starts on 26 July 2024. For para-rowers the Paris Paralympic Games get underway 30 August 2024 and five events will be contested with Paralympic Champions being crowned in each of those events.

Men's Double Sculls

Will the flying French be back with a vengeance this year?

Men's Pair

It's hard enough to qualify one boat for the Olympics, but Nicolas van Sprang will have to do it twice – as he did for the Tokyo Olympics. After qualifying the four last year, van Sprang is back with former partner Guillaume Krommenhoek in the pair. The duo will try to qualify the boat at Final Olympic Qualification Regatta. First step to qualification is a good performance at the European Championships in Szeged.


Women's Pair

Lightweight Women's Double Sculls

Since Tokyo, Emily Craig and Imogen Grant have dominated the lightweight women's double sculls. They won the last two European Championship titles (and World titles), have broken the World Best Time last year, and won the 2023 World Rowing Women's Crew of the Year award. Can they continue their domination in Hungary, for a third straight European title and carry that momentum into the summer and the Olympics?
