



World Rowing Member Federation Accreditation Policy for Classic Rowing Events

Version January 2026

World Rowing's policy is to allow accreditations proportional to the size of the participating teams. The following maximum numbers of accreditations for teams will be issued.

Category	Allowed numbers
Athletes	Officially Entered for racing + a Maximum of 12 spare rowers for a full team
Coach	1 coach per Crew, 1 Head coach for Men, 1 Head coach for Women, 1 Head Coach for Para
Team Manager	Number of Athletes ≤ 20 – 1 Team Manager Number of Athletes > 20 – up to 2 Team Managers Events with Para athletes – 1 Para Team manager
Team Doctors	2 Max per Team
Team Support (physios, equipment staff, trailer drivers, nutrition experts etc)	Number of Athletes < 20 = 6 Team support Number of Athletes 20 to 40 = 9 Team support >40 Athletes = 12 Team support
MF Delegates	2 Max per MF for all events except World Rowing Championships where 3 accreditations per MF will be issued. Additional Board members of the host country MF should be accredited as OC Guest.
MF Guest	No MF Guest accreditations would be issued. It is expected that MF Guests buy tickets for the grandstands to observe the event.

It should be noted carefully that no late accreditation requests will be accepted (unless for a permitted late entry / substituted athlete).
