1. 2026 WR Virtual Indoor Championships

Entries for the 2026 WRVICH will close on **10th February at 23:59 CET**.

Registration can be done on an individual basis by athletes themselves or in groups, by a coach. WR encourages your national teams to take part in this Championship. This event will reward official World Champion titles and apply hard conditions and requirements for athletes regarding anti-doping, performance verification and fairness.

Events & Progression system

This edition offers 3 new individual formats and 2 team events:

- Individual: 1min Sprint, 1000 m, 5000 m
- Team: 1000 m Relay in team of 2, 5000 m in team of 4
- Heats will take place in different Time Zones, on **Saturday 21 February** (1Min/1000 m) and **Sunday 22 February** (5000 m and Relays).
- Finals will take place on **Saturday 28 Feb from 15:00 to 22:30 CET**
 - 1min, 1000 m: Heats Top 6 in each Age category.

- Adaptive: Heats Top 10 in each category
- 5000 m: Heats Top 20 Overall
- Relays: Heats Top 15 in each category

All participants race LIVE from their home, gym, club, etc. by connecting the Concept2 erg to a laptop and accessing the race platform/website.

Member Federations are requested to send their National Team Uniforms to World Rowing to prateek.gumbar@worldrowing.com for approval (Art.13). The designs must clearly show the front, back and side of the uniforms and the dimensions (in cm2) of all logos and identifications on the uniforms must be provided. If your team will have different uniforms for U19, U23 or Senior World Championships, each of those uniforms must be submitted for prior approval. It is reminded that all crews (including para crews) of a National Team must wear the same uniform at any particular regatta.

3. Mixed Events – Mix8+ & Mix2x – Event & Regulations

The World Rowing Council has decided at its latest meeting in January 2026:

At World Rowing Championship events and World Rowing Cups, the preliminary races for Mix2x and Mix8+ will be cancelled (if 6 or less crews are entered).

World Rowing Cups (only) – if there are more than 6 crews entered there will be no Final B, Final C etc. for the Mix2x and Mix8+. Only the Final A will take place. The exact progression system to be used in such a scenario will be shared in due course.
