

2019 Competitor Health & Safety Guidance



The Health & Safety at Work etc. Act 1974 (HASAWA 74)

It is a condition of entry that all Entrants / Competitors / Support team members to whom the Health and Safety at Work Act 1974 applies to i.e. employers and employees as well as self-employed personnel shall comply with the act.

Areas of specific concern are as follows:

- Working at height
- Slips, trips and falls
- Manual Handling
- Lifting operations, lifting equipment regulations
- Working with electricity
- Control of substances hazardous to health
- Fire and emergency
- Personal protective equipment
- Site transport
- Risk Assessment

It should be noted that the list above is not exhaustive and it is the sole responsibility of the Entrant/Competitor to ensure that all appropriate safety requirements are implemented.
